## THE LOUIS D. BRANDEIS AWARD

The Louis D. Brandeis Award is given to an individual for excellence in the law and for commitment to using it for the benefit of the Jewish people. The Louis D. Brandeis Award was established to honor the memory of this distinguished man who exemplified the highest ideals of the Jewish heritage and made enduring contributions to American jurisprudence. Certainly, E. Randol Schoenberg is a worthy recipient of this prestigious award following a long list of distinguished individuals who have received it since 1952.
